

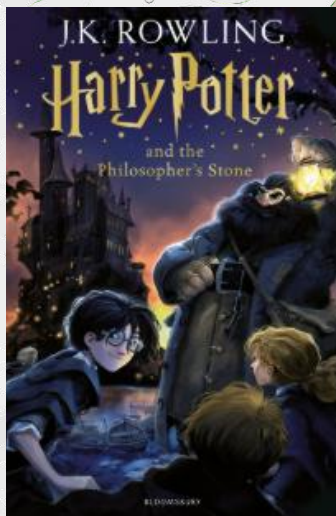
Summer Year 4

English

In English, we will look at a range of narrative and non-narrative texts. We will be focusing on newspaper reports, journalistic writing and creating stories with a strong main character.

We will also be reading 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's stone' and completing work around it.

We are reading...



Maths

In Maths, we will be working on:

- decimals
- money
- time
- shape (position and direction)

We will be solving both fluency, reasoning and problem-solving questions. We will continue to build on our times tables knowledge up to 12×12 in preparation for the MTC in June.

Science

In Science, we are learning about electricity. We will learn about how to keep ourselves safe around electricity and how to build simple circuits using switches.

We will then revise the units from the year and carry out further investigations in our forest school area.

History

In History, we will be studying 'What shaped the Hartlepool we know today?'

In this unit we will find out all about how the town of Hartlepool came to be.

Computing

In Computing, we will look at creating media and how we can edit photographs we take. We will be revisiting programming to create repetitive games.



Geography

In Geography, we will be investigating coasts.

Children will learn where our coasts are situated, how they are formed and how to protect our coasts. We will then complete the unit by looking at map skills including the 8-point compass and 4-figure grid references.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about relationships and how to deal with feelings of jealousy. We will then explore how our bodies change as we grow older.

R.E.

In Religious Education, our question is 'What do we know about the Bible and why is it important to Christians?'

We will focus on the story of Creation, Incarnation and Salvation.

We will also recap on our knowledge of different religions including Christianity.

Art and D.T.

In Art, we will build upon our prior knowledge of sculpture. We will develop our own mask.

In D.T., children will use their knowledge of electricity and circuits to create their own torch.



Music

In Music, we will be exploring Samba and Carnival sounds. We will be getting the feel of the music and culture of South America. We will be introduced to Samba and the sights and sounds of the Rio carnival.

Then we will draw upon our understanding of repeating patterns in Music.

French

In French, we will be learning about how to tell someone when we are feeling unwell. We will also explore jungle animals.

We will explore how to converse about the weather and how to order an ice cream.

PE

In Physical Education, we are developing skills in cricket and tennis.

After half term, we will be focusing on Athletics. Children will take part in track and field events.
