


French

Through the Primary Languages Network (PLN) French curriculum, pupils at our school develop the foundations for understanding and communicating in another language. Learning French broadens their horizons, deepens cultural awareness, and fosters a lifelong enthusiasm for language learning.

Our French curriculum is fully aligned with the National Curriculum for Languages, enabling pupils to:

- Understand and respond to spoken and written French.
- Speak with increasing confidence, fluency, and accuracy.
- Write for a range of purposes using simple sentences and grammatical
- Discover and appreciate other cultures and ways of life.



Using the Primary Languages Network scheme, learning is a uctured around progressive units that build knowledge and skills across four key strands:

- Listening understanding and responding to familiar words, phrases, and sentences.
- Speaking using accurate pronunciation to express ideas, ask and answer questions, and engage in short conversations.

By following the PLN progression framework, children move from early recognition of sounds and words in Key Stage 1 to more confident speaking, reading, and writing by the
